What is a Room Representative? A Room Representative is a parent or guardian who volunteers to be a communication link between the classroom teacher, the PTA board and the parents of their child's classmates. They also support and facilitate the needs of the classroom teacher. PTA membership is required for this position.

Goals for the Room Representative: To assist the classroom teacher, bring parents into closer contact with the school and build a strong classroom network among the parents. Your enthusiasm for this position will demonstrate to parents and teachers that PTA involvement creates excitement and a sense of accomplishment for everyone. It is a fun job!

Responsibilities: Three Room Representatives are assigned to each classroom and the responsibilities are divided between the three. Job responsibilities include planning and executing the Halloween Party, Valentine Party, and Liaison for the classroom.

Guidelines for Party or Classroom Volunteers Anyone volunteering to help with a party or in a classroom must sign in at the OMS office. A Volunteer form must be on file with OMS. If it is not on file you will be asked to fill out the form and provide a driver's license for identification. An identification badge will be given to you and it must be visible and worn at all times.
